

LIST OF SOME IMPORTANT COMPETITIVE EXAMINATIONS

1. **Mathematics Olympiad** (THE ASSAM ACADEMY OF MATHEMATICS): Assam Academy of Mathematics conducts Mathematics every year for once, (category-IX to XI) on the first Sunday in the month of May. The Academy also conducts Mathematics Olympiad every year usually in the first Sunday of September for three categories viz. Category-I (V and VI), Category-II (VII and VIII), Category-III (IX to XI)
2. **NATIONAL TALENT SEARCH EXAMINATION** (N.T.S.E.): N.T.S.E. (applicable for Class X) is conducted by the GOVT. OF INDIA and also Class VIII (for those children who are in Below Poverty Line category).
3. **DPS Science & Maths TALENT EXAMINATION** (SMTE-CLASS IX) ensures the following:
 - i. Participation certificate to every student appearing in Level 1 exam.
 - ii. Report on performance of every student in Level 1 examination.
 - iii. Merit certificate to all students appearing in Level 2 examination.
 - iv. Honouring top 3 rank holders in the Level 2 examination with attractive awards and certificates.
 - v. Awards to approximately first 100 meritorious students in Level 2 examination.
4. **THE GREEN OLYMPIAD** : This is an initiative of the Energy resources institute (TERI) [classes IV to X]. Students are awarded with Merit and Distinction certificate if they qualify for that.
5. **ASSET** (Assessment of Scholastic Skills through Educational Testing) The test provides insight into the students' subject specific strengths and weakness. The test is conducted by the Educational Initiatives, Ahmedabad every year in the month of August-September.
6. **SCIENCE OLYMPIAD FOUNDATION** conducts the following tests for the subject enrichment of the students (Classes I-X): National Science Olympiad (NSO), National Cyber Olympiad (NCO) International Mathematics Olympiad (IMO) & International English Olympiad (IEO).
7. **Chemistry Olympiad** : It is conducted by Assam Chemical Society for Classes IX to XII. Students securing 60% and above are rewarded with certificate of Merit and first three position holders are eligible for taking participation in National Chemistry Olympiad.
8. **Kishore Vaigyanik Protsahan Yojana (KVPY)** : It is an on-going National Programme of Fellowship in Basic Sciences, initiated and funded by the Department of Science and Technology, Govt. of India to promote career in Scientific Courses and Research. The advertisement for the KVPY Fellowship appears in all the National Dailies normally on the Technology Day (May 11) and the Second Sunday of July every year. Generous fellowships are provided up to the Pre-Ph.D. level to the selected KVPY Fellows.
9. **IAPT Exam** (Indian Association of Physics Teachers) : This exam is conducted for the students of Classes - XI & XII.
10. **National Scientific Creativity Competition** : It is a National Level Competition organised by the Ministry of Science & Technology to evaluate creativity & innovative scientific ideas.
11. **KAMP NASTA Exam** : It provides comprehensive look at the wide array of academic areas focusing on subjects like Science, Social Science, Mathematics and Digital Literacy for grades upto 10th. For 11th & 12th, it is an Aptitude and Career Advisory Test.

PLAY GROUP : I & II

1. Red Shirt, half sleeve with pointed small collar.
2. Red & White check tunic (A line) 1 inch above knees.
3. Black school shoes with buckles.
4. White socks with red stripes.

CLASSES : I TO XII

1. Bottle Green Tie with DPS Logo & half sleeve white shirt with pointed small collar (without pocket).
2. (A) White box pleated skirt for classes - I to III (knee length).
(B) From class IV onwards divided skirts (knee length) are to be worn compulsorily.
3. Black shoes (medium toes) with buckles. White canvas shoes on Games / P.E. days.
4. White socks with bottle green stripes.
5. Bottle green belt
6. Bottle green ribbons / hair band / clip.

WINTER : NOVEMBER - MARCH

PLAY GROUP : I & II

1. V - necked grey sweater with red stripes around neck and cuffs.
2. Red full trousers.
3. Red scarf / muffler / cap.
4. Black school shoes (medium toes) with buckles. White canvas shoes on P.E. days.
5. White socks with red stripes.

CLASSES : I TO III

1. Full sleeves white shirt with pointed small collar.
2. Grey full trousers.
3. V-necked pullover of bottle green colour (with school monogram).
4. Bottle green tie and belt.
5. Black school shoes (medium toes) with buckles. White canvas shoes on P.E. days.
6. Grey socks with green stripes.
7. Bottle green ribbons / hair band.
8. Bottle green scarf / muffler / cap.

CLASSES : IV TO XII

1. White full sleeve shirt with pointed collar. (without pocket)
2. Grey high waist full trousers.
3. School Blazer (Single breasted) with school monogram affixed on the breast pocket.
4. Tie as per the blazer's colour and green coloured belt.
5. Black school shoes (medium toes) with buckles. White canvas shoes on P.E. days.
6. Grey socks with green stripes.
7. Bottle green ribbons / hair band.
8. Bottle green scarf / muffler / cap.
